A MUSLIM RELIGIOUS LEADER SEEKS THE ONE TRUE GOD

"Jesus will not make you ashamed."

These are the words one Pakistani brother heard the Lord say while helping others seek asylum outside Afghanistan. Since the withdrawal of the US military in late August, Biglife's on-the-ground care for Afghan people is at full capacity. Moving them away from crisis and into safety, many Christ followers are putting themselves in harm's way, risking their lives, and helping Afghans settle in Pakistan with the main goal of displaying the Gospel. While most of the Afghans do not know the love of Christ, they are fleeing the most religious people on Earth—the Taliban.

There was one such family that made their way over the border and upon arrival began to seek help in the form of shelter and food. The head of this household was an Imam, a member of the Muslim clergy.

"Is your guy a Christian?" the Imam asked, motioning to the brother who met his family after crossing the border. The Imam whispered, "I am looking for the one true God."

The Gospel was shared with the Imam that day. Since taking his questions to Christ, he has changed his language from speaking of Allah as god, to *Isa (Jesus)* as Lord.

Several people in this situation are seeing the differences between Christians and the Muslim religion, and in turn are questioning the faith they have put in Allah. Experiencing the love of Christ poured out for his family through Biglife, the Imam's story is one of many where the light of Jesus is shining in horrific darkness.
